The Certificate III in Spoken & Written English is a general English course designed for students, typically IELTS level 4.5, who wish to improve their English language proficiency for study, work or travel. The flexible nature of the Certificate enables students to focus on general English skills development or to focus on particular areas such as listening, speaking, reading or writing, depending on the needs of the individual student. Students also extend their Grammar and Vocabulary, and have opportunities to improve their Pronunciation.

Course Description

The Certificate IV in Spoken & Written English-Further Education is designed specifically for students who want to continue their studies at tertiary level and/or wish to sit for an IELTS exam. A typical entry level would be IELTS 5.0 and above. The focus is on equipping students with the skills required to study at a tertiary institution in any English speaking country. The course covers academic writing and reading, which includes planning and writing of essays, correct referencing convention, critical evaluation and research skills. Students also study note taking, oral presentation and exam techniques.
